



In A Level French you should...

After Each Lesson...

- Complete homework set during the lesson, check Edulink app for this.
- Add any handouts to your folder, divided by topic.
- Re-read material from the lesson and highlight key vocabulary.
- Prepare any questions to ask your teacher based on any misconceptions.
- Ensure you have understood any new grammar points and ask if you are unsure.

Every Week...

- Use Quizlet to practice the vocabulary covered that week.
- Act on any feedback given, particularly to written responses.
- Plan and complete a written task. This could be a summary, translation, or when appropriate, a longer essay response.
- Meet with some of your classmates to practice speaking informally.
- Access French news online to keep abreast of current events.

Every Term...

- Use any information you have gathered from news websites or other sources to update your topic mind maps/revision for the speaking exam.
- Add to your preparation for your Independent Research Project.
- Ensure you have prepared for and practiced at least two speaking cards on the current topic

Throughout the Year...

- Revisit previously learned topics more than once.
- Continuously practice essay writing techniques and reuse essay writing terminology until you are comfortable with it.
- Practice vocabulary several times a week.
- Create flash cards and test yourself regularly.
- Redraft exam answers in green pen in response to teacher feedback.
