



In A-Level Maths/Further Maths you should....

After each lesson...

If you have any doubt or insecurity of anything that has been taught in the lesson and this has not been addressed during lesson time, please make a note to attend Maths Help on a Thursday lunchtime in M9.

Any questions that you have not been able to complete in class, use your private study time to do this.

Every week...

Complete homework set by your relevant teacher. This can include written homework and electronic homework set on Integral.

All your assessed works should be filed in the ring binder folder that you were given at the start of the year – including the pink analysis and feedback sheets.

Maths Help sessions run on Thursday Lunchtimes every week in M9.

Every term ...

Different retrieval tasks will be set either as homework or in your lesson.

Lesson retrieval tasks will be in the form of timed questions.

There will be several tests during a term. These will either be based on Pure topics or Applied topics.

After every test, it is your responsibility to use your private study time to do any corrections in light of wrong answers. If you are unable to correct them then please speak to your teachers or attend Maths Help on a Thursday Lunchtime in M9.

Review your EBI's on the feedback sheets so that you know where to focus your Private Study revision.

Every year...

Revisit previously learned topics more than once.

Physics and Maths Tutor is a good place to access past paper questions – ensure you are getting good practise with Exam Past Paper questions.

You will get the chance to sit a Senior Maths Challenge which will give you the opportunity to gain accreditation should you achieve highly.

You will be given access to attend the annual Christmas Maths Lecture.
